The workshop will provide opportunities to engage in 'hands on' activities to help participants follow processes to identify the evidence base for and the impact of your activities/programs, develop outcomes and tools to measure them, and reflect on programs that are relevant to the reformed TEI funding programs and/or an outcomes measurement framework.

Learning Outcomes

- Improved knowledge of what evidence informed, outcomes focused means for your work
- Increased confidence to engage in program planning and development
- Better understanding of performance accountability and how to engage in continuous improvement of your program
- Increased awareness of the value of data and evidence in program design, delivery and reflection

Activities during the workshop include using a FACSIAR template to develop a program logic for one of the activities you currently deliver. It is assumed that participants will have a basic knowledge of Outcomes Measurement.
